

## Appendix A

### I. APPROVED HANDGUNS

Any service (Duty) weapons carried by a member while on duty will be semi-automatic 9mm, .40 or .45 caliber. Any commissioned member hired prior to January 1st, 2022 may keep their 40, or 45 caliber Duty handguns in service. Any commissioned member hired after January 1st, 2022 shall only place a 9mm caliber Duty weapon into service.

Authorized service weapon manufacturers include:

- Glock
- Colt
- Smith and Wesson
- Springfield Armory
- Sig Sauer
- TRIARC Systems
- Shadow Systems

Due to the many weapon variations and features each manufacturer offers, if a member wishes to carry a service weapon other than what is authorized above; using Guardian Tracking the member must request and receive written permission from the Professional Standards Captain stating the exact make, model, finish/color, and any attachments of the pistol they wish to carry as a service weapon. Attaching a photo is highly recommended.

As it applies to handguns, the Office will maintain the ability to provide armorer service for Glock, brand weapons. If a member chooses to carry another brand of service weapon or secondary weapon, yearly armoring expense will be the responsibility of the member as outlined in Section III B.

Approved secondary weapons include:

- Glock
- Colt
- Smith and Wesson
- Springfield Armory
- Sig Sauer
- TRIARC Systems
- Shadow Systems
- Ruger (revolver only)

in .380 automatic .38 special/357, (revolver) and 9mm, .40 or .45 caliber. caliber (if a commissioned member was hired prior to January 1st, 2022, they may keep their 40, or 45 caliber secondary handguns in service). Any commissioned member hired after January 1st, 2022 shall only place a .380 automatic, 38 special/ 357, (revolver) and 9mm caliber secondary weapons into service.

Due to the many weapon variations and features each manufacturer offers, if a member wishes to carry a secondary weapon, other than what is authorized above: using Guardian Tracking the member must request and receive written permission from the Professional Standards Captain stating the exact make, model, finish/color, and any attachments of the pistol they wish to carry as a secondary weapon. Attaching a photo is highly recommended.

#### Authorized Equipment (or Modifications):

Authorized weapons may have the following attachments, which do not affect the overall mechanical function of the weapons or compromise the internal or external safeties of the firearm.

- Extended magazine release.
- High visibility sights (night sights).
- Ambidextrous safeties
- Extended magazines with base plate.
- Tactical lights (lasers not allowed).
  
- Red dot pistol sights:
  - Trijicon RMR Type 2 - 3.25 MOA/ 1 MOA
  - Holosun
  - Sig Sauer Romeo/ Pro 3.0 MOA
    - All commissioned personnel will complete the DCSO red dot transition course training from a certified firearms instructor and demonstrate proficiency in the use of the red dot sight prior to placing the firearm into service.
    - Deputies who have completed the HRLETA Academy with their red dot sight are exempt from completing the DCSO red dot transition course.
    - All handguns utilizing a red dot sight must have suppressor height back up sights or RDS height back up sights (unless the system allows use of the original sights).
    - Commissioned members are strongly encouraged to replace their optic batteries once a year.
  
- Ported barrels are not authorized.
- Evolution One Zero MK 2, and Parker Mountain Machine compensators are authorized if factory installed (or by a certified department armorer and notated on the Authorized Weapon Sheet).

Using Guardian Tracking the member must request and receive written permission from the Professional Standards Captain for any other color or finish variable for an authorized weapon.

## II. APPROVED RIFLES

- Colt .223 caliber AR or M4 platform carbines.
- Armalite .223 caliber M15A2 models, M15A4 models, LE15A2 and LE15A4. Only Armalite rifles put into service prior to May 1, 2016 will be authorized. No Armalite rifles will be approved or put into service after May 1, 2016.
- Sig Sauer .223 caliber rifles, SIG MCX or SIG556xi carbine, Sig Sauer M400 SBR (Department Owned).
- Smith & Wesson Model M&P15.
- Daniel Defense 5.56mm, AR and M4 platforms.
- TRIARC Systems 5.56mm Model TSR-15SBR (Office Owned and Assigned Only).
- TRIARC Systems 5.56mm /.223 platforms.
- Bravo Company USA.
- Geissele Automatics.

- Authorized makes/models for specialized teams (i.e. SWAT, DMR, See [P&P-S-101](#)).
- Rifle makes/models authorized and placed into service prior to June 1, 2006.

No member-owned Short-Barreled Rifles (SBRs), moderators, silencers, suppressors, or select-fire (tri-burst or auto) will be approved for carry. *The Office will provide (Office owned and purchased) this type of equipment for members depending on assignment and need.*

Authorized weapons may have the following attachments, which do not affect the overall mechanical function of the weapons or compromise the internal or external safeties of the firearm.

Approved Equipment / Modifications / Attachments

- Barrel length must be a minimum of 16 inches; no member-owned Short-Barreled Rifles (SBRs), moderators, silencers, suppressors, or select-fire (tri-burst or auto) will be approved for carry.
  - 1, 2 or 3-point slings.
  - No folding stocks unless; using Guardian Tracking the member must request and receive written permission from the Professional Standards Captain stating the exact stock they wish to carry. Attaching a photo is highly recommended.
  - Electronic sights, so long as the weapon is equipped with back up iron sights capable of functioning independently, with or without magnification up to 4x.
  - Vertical grip, hand stops.
  - Picatinny/ free floated style rails.
  - Tactical lights.
  - LaRue Tactical MBT-2S Trigger, Geissele Super Semi-Automatic SSA trigger, or Geissele 2 Stage (G2S) Trigger (must be installed by the factory or a certified department armorer and notated on the Authorized Weapon Sheet).
  - Any other color or finish variable must be approved; using Guardian Tracking the member must request and receive written permission from the Professional Standards Captain. Attaching a photo is highly recommended.
- Authorized equipment for specialized teams (i.e. SWAT, DMR, See P&P-S-101).

### III. APPROVED SHOTGUNS:

- Remington Model 870 pump action models only. 18” or 20” barrels.
- Mossberg 500/ 590 pump action models only. 18” or 20” barrels.
- Authorized makes / models for specialized teams (i.e. SWAT, SORT-See P&P-S-101).

Approved Equipment / Modifications / Attachments include the following:

- 1, 2 or 3-point slings.
- Electronic sights.
- Tactical lights (no lasers).
- Extended magazine tube.
- Side-saddle ammunition carrier.
